

Finishing School

LBSITW in association with **Dept. of Social Welfare, Kerala** is organizing a finishing school programme in **Networking** course. The finishing school is aimed to provide various upskilling programmes to fresh graduates passing out of various colleges, institutions and universities in order to make them "**employable**" or "**self employable**" and **enable them to transform** themselves from being job seekers to **job providers**. The primary objective is to make the fresh B.Tech graduates become "Job Ready".

We are offering the following program under the networking Course:

- **Troubleshooting Computer Networks**

This Programme is meant for B.Tech graduates in any discipline, who want to strengthen their skills in selective areas like Network Administration, Troubleshooting Networks etc.

In these courses, you will examine

- Basic networking and identify different networking models.
- Describe the basics of data movement, physical media, and network connectivity devices.
- Use the OSI model and understand Ethernet, Token Ring, FDDI, and wireless networks.
- Understand data routing and common network protocols such as TCP/IP, IPv6 etc.
- Basic Wiring standards, structured cabling concepts.

- Distinguish the different methods used to connect networks together through the public carrier services.
- Understand the different methods of remote networking.
- Understand and implement relevant aspects of network security.
- Understand and implement network troubleshooting procedures.
- Describe the basics of the network operating systems in use today.
- Basics of Network Administration.
- Soft skill development (Confidence building, communication skills, language proficiency, presentation skills etc).

1. Students will be able to prepare themselves suitably in order to get employment in industry immediately after passing out the course.

2. The programs are designed as per the industry needs since these programs are developed based upon the globally accepted industry standards.

3. Lab facility is also provided to the students to access various learning resources.

Eligibility

- **Troubleshooting Computer Networks**

Women candidates with minimum of 60% mark (50% for SC/ST) for B.Tech (in any discipline) eligible to apply.
Max age limit: 28 years as on 01/01/10.

Selection

Selection will be based on the Test / Interview conducted by the LBSITW. Reservations as per Government of Kerala norms will be followed.

Course Fee

Course Fee is Rs. 1500/- (Rupees One Thousand Five Hundred only). Fee is exempted for SC/ST, OEC and SEBC candidates on production of community and income certificate from the competent authority.

Last date for submitting completed Application is extended upto **25th February 2010**.
